What is this qualification about?

It provides an introduction to teaching and training adults and is an essential first step towards practitioner status for all teachers, trainers and instructors.

Who is it for?

This award is for all new and existing entrants who either may not have prior experience or who already deliver teaching, learning, training and instruction to adults in the lifelong learning sector and need to commence their first steps towards gaining their professional qualifications.

What sorts of things will it cover?

- Roles and responsibilities of teachers/trainers in the sector
- Inclusive practice
- Planning and delivering a session
- Assessment principles and practice

How you will learn and be assessed?

You will learn in the classroom or on the job in the work environment. Assessment will be a combination of a short portfolio of evidence; practical skills, demonstrations and a micro teach assessment.
